Cyrus enjoys engaging with the sensory glove!




Maya is pretending to be a chef at a restaurant! Hands on cooking activities help children develop confidence and skill.

Pre-school are learning about using different colour powders to mix. Cliff is happy with his orange paint!!!




Nana uses the stencils to help her paint her amazing picture!
